Dear Sir,

We are pleased to inform that the **48th Junior National Aquatic Championships-2022** will be conducted from **16th to 20th July 2022** by The Odisha State Swimming Association under the auspices of Swimming Federation of India.

Swimming and Waterpolo events will be conducted at the following venue

Biju Patnaik Swimming Pool cum Sports Complex
Kalinga Stadium, BHUBANESWAR, ODISHA.

The Championships will be held in the following Age Groups in Swimming for Boys & Girls in accordance with FINA rules. Swimming competition will be conducted as long course events in 50M pool

SWIMMING: JUNIOR GROUP Boys & Girls

Group - I 15-17 years – Born in the year 2005, 2006, 2007

Group - II 12-14 years – Born in the year 2008, 2009, 2010

WATERPOLO: Water polo for Junior Boys & Girls – Born in the year 2005 and after

The Maximum 13 Water polo players names must be submitted in the Entry Form. Team Entry will not be accepted after **1st July 2022**. Two teams from each zone will be entered on the basis of Zonal tournament/trials. Zonal tournament circular is already sent along with Junior National Aquatic championships-2022 circular.

Rules

1. All events will be conducted as per FINA rules
2. Swimmers (Athletes) registered on SFI General Management System (GMS) database and having a Unique Identification Number (UID) duly renewed for FY 2022-23 i.e., Valid UID, before last date of sending the entry will only be eligible for participation.
3. Having a valid UID is an eligibility criteria and swimmers/players must qualify as per procedure mentioned in circular from his/her respective state/ board under which they have registered on GMS system.

4. Print/Digital copy of valid UID card will be carried by swimmer and presented when reporting at National Championship and when requested to do so by the officials in charge of conduct of event.
5. As per SFI General Council decision a swimmer shall be allowed to enter in Maximum 5 Individual events in Junior National Aquatic Championship subject to meeting the qualification time standard for the event entered.
6. No more than 2 entries will be permitted for each swimming event in both genders from any state/sports board.
7. Qualification for National Championship will be as per the qualification criteria/procedure laid down in this circular.
8. Swimmers qualifying for National Championship will be deemed to be obligated to follow FINA rules of conduct and competition.
9. All Swimming Events will be swum as Heats and Finals except Relays & 800m , 1500m Freestyle
10. Only Top 8 times swum in the Heats will progress to the Final
11. If the swimmer fails to achieve qualifying time/standard at National Championship in her/his event, the unit will have to pay Rs.500/- as penalty per player per event irrespective of reason and the swimmer who fails to achieve the qualifying standard in the heats will not be given participation certificate.
12. If Swimmer fails to enter the event after acceptance of his/her entry as per qualification procedure, the member unit will be liable for penalty of Rs.500/- per event per player and the swimmer will not be permitted to participate in the rest of championships.
13. If the swimmer qualifies for finals and fails to swim the Final, the unit will be liable for penalty of Rs.1000/- per event per swimmer and the swimmer will not be permitted to participate in the rest of championships.
14. Withdrawal of entry will not be permitted after the "Team Manager Meeting" to be conducted before the start of the championship. Location and time the "Team Manager Meeting" will be posted on the notice board at swimming venue.
15. Medals and Certificates will be awarded to the Finalist of the Relay event. Certificate reprint request due damage or loss will be charged at Rs 500/-
16. Best Swimmer Award in both genders will be given based on overall performance of Individual swimmer in the championships.
17. Waterpolo Championships will be conducted in accordance with FINA Rules for Boys & Girls.

Qualification System and Criteria – Swimming

1. Qualification Time Standard for swimming events at 48th Junior National Championship 2022 are given as part of this circular. The Times Standard Table represents times for allowing two entry or one entry for both male & female in respective group (age category)
2. Each State/ Sports Board shall enter swimmers for the 48th Junior National Championship 2022 upon verification of age and UID status (validity) for the appropriate age category viz Group I– [15-17 years] – Born in the year 2005, 2006, 2007 & Group II – [12-14 years] Born in 2008, 2009, 2010
3. Individual Swimmers shall be permitted to be entered in maximum 5 events subject to achieving one of the qualification times for each of the event entered
4. Each State/ Sports Board will be entitled to enter max 2 swimmer in each event provided **both swimmers** have achieved the time standard for allowing 2 (two) entries i.e., faster time standard and each State / Sports Board will enter **only one swimmer** in each event provided the swimmer has achieved the minimum required time standard i.e., 1 (single) entry time or slower time standard. No reserve swimmer will be permitted for individual events
5. Relay Team will be entered only from swimmers who have qualified for individual events.

6. In case no swimmer from a particular State / Sports Promotion Board has qualified for any of the events, the member unit may enter a maximum of 6 swimmers in each gender or a total of 12 swimmers for participation at National Championship. Such swimmers will not be entitled to enter more than 2 event each and will be eligible to receive participation certificate.
7. Entries will be received in prescribed ONLINE format only.
8. A copy of forms duly completed in all respect, along with a copy of Results of State Championship/ Trial results, Entry Fees of each participant be submitted by Regd.A.D./ Speed Post to the General Secretary SFI at AHMEDABAD address only so as to reach on or before **01st July 2022**. If the detail in all respect along with State Championship/ Trials results are not received by General Secretary SFI at AHMEDABAD on or before the last date of entry, it will not be entertained.
9. ENTRY FEE Rs.40/- will be paid for each event entered, Relay Team fee Rs.200/-, Water Polo team fees Rs.500/-

Qualification System and Criteria – Water polo

1. All State Units will be required to play the Zonal Championship / Trials in their respective zones. Top 2 teams from each Zone will enter the National Championship in both boys and girls category.
2. Any State having multiple club teams must conduct their state level Trials for selection of team to be entered in the Zonal Championship / Trials.
3. Players born 2005 and after will only be entered in both genders
4. ENTRY FEE Rs.500/- will be paid by each team entered.

Medical Board: As decided by SFI, The SFI President will appoint a scrutiny committee (Medical Board) consisting of 3 (three) members and 2 (two) local doctors to determine the age of the participants. Any participant may be requested to present themselves to the Medical Board if deemed necessary. Necessary action will be taken against those who furnish incorrect information and/or certificate regarding age of participant. Swimmers will not be permitted to participate in the Competition on recommendation of the board.

Opening Ceremony: All units are requested to ensure that their Team must participate in march-past in state colors or ceremonial dress in the Opening Ceremony. It is compulsory for all participating teams to participate in the march-past. Unit must carry two flags of their units for all the ceremonial purposes

Medal Ceremony: Swimmers will present themselves to the master of ceremony in appropriate clothing preferably their state kit (if available). Under no circumstances will they be allowed to the podium in swimwear.

Team Officials: Number of Team Officials permitted with each team are as under.

- 1 to 5 Competitors - 1 Team Official
- 6 to 10 Competitors – 2 Team Officials
- 11 to 20 Competitors – 3 Team Officials
- 21 to 35 Competitors – 4 Team Officials
- 36 and more competitors- 5 Team Officials

NO EXTRA TEAM OFFICIALS WILL BE PERMITTED WITH THE TEAM

Covid-19 Guidelines:

1. All participants and officials will be obligated to follow the state covid guidelines and SOP in force during the period
2. Mask and Social Distancing to be maintained and it is mandatory for all on the venue of the event.
3. Only participants and team officials will be permitted in Sports Arena. No spectator / parents / relatives / Extra officials will be permitted to enter in the venue premises.
4. Violation of Covid guidelines or Competition rules will lead to debarring of the participants / Official
